Since then, there has been a conference every 18th months (or roughly so). We have met in various places in Sweden, Norway, Finland, and, most recently, in Denmark.

Next year, the conference will return to **Stockholm**.

The overarching topic we will be exploring is **how interfaith dialogue and interfaith cooperation can contribute to more peaceful, resilient, and inclusive societies**.

There will be ample opportunities to learn from researchers, theologians, practitioners, and, not least, each other. We will also learn by visiting other faith communities.

**English** will be the main language of the conference.
